REACH/RoHS Declaration

Declaration on Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and the Council of 8 June 2011 on restricting the use of specific hazardous substances in electrical and electronic appliances, modified most recently by delegated Directive 2015/863 dated 04.06.2015.

In accordance with Schedule 1 of Directive 2011/65/EU, (with the exception of No. 9 monitoring and control instruments including monitoring and control instruments in industry) the products manufactured by Isabellenhütte Heusler GmbH & Co. KG are not subject to this directive, but are to a large part integrated into such products. In line with current status it can be confirmed that all Isabellenhütte products comply with Directive 2011/65/EU and do not contain any substances above the limits indicated in the directive (exceptions to this are products for space applications). In addition there are no applicable exceptions within the meaning of Annexes III and IV of the directive.

The same applies to information obligations in accordance with Art. 33 of Directive (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and the Council dated 18 December 2006 on the registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemical substances (REACH), published on 30 December 2006 in EU Official Journal 396/1 (date: 05.09.2015). Within the meaning of the directive Isabellenhütte Heusler GmbH & Co. KG regards itself as a downstream user or supplier of products. An in-depth check on the list of substances (as of: 12.01.2017) confirms that there are currently no SVHC substances above the limit of 0.1 % mass in the products of Isabellenhütte Heusler GmbH & Co. KG.

In order to ensure transparency the international material data system (IMDS: www.mdssystem.com) is applied. This is in line with the high standards of the automobile industry. With the help of the system all materials which are used by suppliers and are integrated in our products are checked for compliance. In addition, with the aid of this instrument all globally applicable legal regulations and restrictions on substances are covered (see GADSL - Global Automotive Declarable Substance List).
